

PRINCESS IN WALES.

To Plas Dinas, home of Lord Snowden's father, Princess Margaret paid a brief visit during her short tour of Wales. With Mr. Ronald Armstrong Jones was his young wife.

Plas Dinas is not very far away from Caernarvon Castle, which was begun by Edward 1st in 1284. There was a loyal welcome there to the Princess and her husband.

The old legend has it that after conquering Wales, Edward showed his infant son to the people of Caernarvon and named him Prince of Wales. The last Prince of Wales, now Duke of Windsor, was invested in 1911.

One of the oldest industries of North Wales is the production of slate. The Princess and her party visited the Dinorwic Quarries, the largest in the world. The slate is first obtained by blasting, using the smallest charge possible.
