

QUEEN MOTHER GIVES COLOURS.

The Queen Mother arrives in Montreal by airliner and is welcomed to Canada by Governor General Vanier, and his wife. Also there to greet Her Majesty is the Canadian Prime Minister and Mrs. Diefenbaker.

The main object of the Queen Mother's trip to the Dominion is to present new colours to the Canadian Black Watch. Her personal standard flies at McGill University Memorial Stadium, where the ceremony is to take place.

Canada's oldest Highland Regiment is celebrating its centenary year. It was first known as the Royal Light Infantry, but in 1905 it was allied with the Black Watch.

The new colours replace those which were destroyed by fire 13 years ago. They will serve for all three battalions of the regiment. Canadians are proud of it though these soldiers of the regiment are, they are no less proud of their attachment to the Highlands, whose martial glory the Black Watch have demonstrated in battle for 200 years.
