And here seem to be the answers. At an Officers' Training School,

Junior leaders are put through every phase of drill and instructional

training, to equip them for the task of future leadership. In time,

they command. A competant officer is able to use all types of weapons

In the lecture rooms, classes in Military tactics first absorb theory - - -

--- and then proceed to put it into practice. After having received individual instruction, the officers are later put through full scale field exercises which closely resemble the real thing.

The whole of these exercises are carried out by officers only. Pully trained, they go through this special hardening course for modern warfare conditions, later returning to their units to put their men through the same exercises.
