COMMENTARY

This boy is not expected to live, he was not immunised. Every year three thousand children die like this from diptheria. This child need not have died, he could have been immunised and so protected against diptheria. See what happened in Scotland last year. 1,200,000 children, two thirds were immunised, attacked by diptheria. Of those immunised only one died, of those unprotected over 400 died.
