

The Duke of Edinburgh --- who was to take the salute --- arrived with the Duchess of Kent at the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst, when the Duchess's son, the young Duke of Kent, was on parade. This was the occasion of the annual Sovereign's Parade -- at which Senior Officer-Cadets, including the Duke of Kent, parade for the last time before receiving their Commission as army officers.

After the inspection --- the parade marches past.

Then follows the address by Field Marshal the Duke of Edinburgh.

Following the address, the Duke presents the Sword of Honour to the best Officer-Cadet of the year; while the Queen's Medal, goes to the Officer-Cadet who is first in order of merit.

And the parade marches off, to the music of Auld Lang Syne.
